



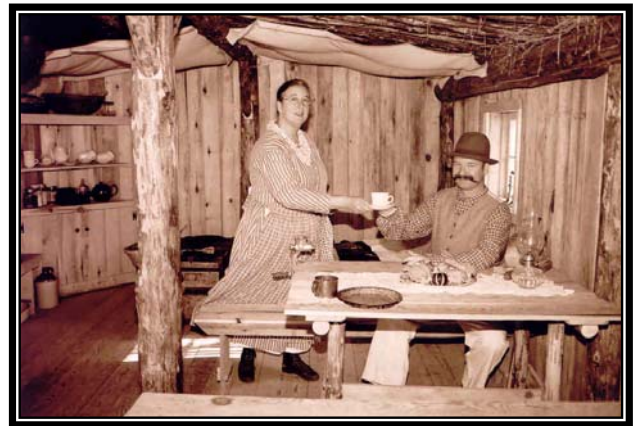

Throw an atlatl, the precursor to the bow and arrow, and visit a buffalo drive lane and pound, the site of a fall buffalo hunt. Finally, sing in time to the dip of the paddle as you arrive at the Buffalo Stone Cafe en canot.
