PRHC is looking for a physiatrist to join our hospital and take over a well established practice in physical medicine and rehabilitation. This opportunity includes an inpatient consultation service and an outpatient service with clinic space and clerical support.

PRHC's integrated Stroke Unit (ISU) has staff dedicated to the care of stroke patients. The stroke unit provides both acute and rehab care following stroke. The ISU benefits from a multi-disciplinary and collaborative approach to care with excellent support from specialty services including nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech language therapists, registered dietitians, pharmacy, and social work. PRHC has recently been awarded Stroke Distinction by Accreditation Canada.

Outpatient clinic services offered include orthopedic rehabilitation, musculoskeletal care, spasticity management, amputee clinic, botox injections, electromyography (EMG) studies and access to fluoroscopy. Leadership opportunity available as well.
